W.R. Mathieson Award

This award, initiated in 1983 by the Association of Municipal Electrical Utilities of Ontario (AMEU), is named after W.R. Mathieson, who served as General Manager of the AMEU, contributing to the municipal distribution systems of the province over a period of 34 years.

The W.R. Mathieson Award is presented when, in the opinion of the Selection Committee, a local electricity distribution utility has distinguished itself among its peers by:

- (a) Demonstrating outstanding performance and leadership in the electric utility field in Ontario;
- (b) Having enhanced the work and prestige of the Association.

Nominations for this award must be made by an individual or utility from outside the utility being nominated. The award is not necessarily presented on an annual basis.

Nominations for the W.R. Mathieson Award can be submitted by Member Utilities, Association Committees or the Board of Directors. All nominations should be forwarded to the Chief Executive Officer in writing no later than February 1st of the next calendar year.
